

# crochet pattern by babayaga



## Deer - Woollky - The Forrest Troop

Woollky, wool balls - brought to life by a forest witch to guard her hut. Night watch and air patrol of the forest. Deer - he can talk with mushrooms and plants.

### Abbreviations:

R - round  
ch - chain  
sl st - slip stitch  
sc - single crochet  
hdc - half double crochet  
dc - double crochet  
inc - increase / make two sc form one loop  
dec - decrease / invisible decrease or two S.C. together  
fo - fasten off  
FLO - Front Loops Only  
**Mark first stitch of each round.**

### You will need:

- creamy, brown, black and white yarn
- hook 3,5 mm or 4 mm
- polyester fiberfill
- yarn needle

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## Body

Creamy.

R1 - 6 sc in magic ring  
or make 2 ch and make 6 sc in  
2nd ch form the hook (6)

R2 - inc around (12)

R3 - \*1 sc, 1 inc\* around (18)

R4 - \*2 sc, 1 inc\* around (24)

R5 - \*3 sc, 1 inc\* around (30)

R6 - \*4 sc, 1 inc\* around (36)

R7 - \*5 sc, 1 inc\* around (42)

R8 - R20 - sc around (42)

R21 - \*5 sc, 1 dec\* around (36)

R22 - sc around (36)

R23 - \*4 sc, 1 dec\* around (30)

R24 - \*3 sc, 1 dec\* around (24)

Start stuffing.

R25 - \*2 sc, 1 dec\* around (18)

R26 - \*1 sc, 1 dec\* around (12)

R27 - 4 x dec

FO and sew.

## Arms

Make 2. Creamy.

R1 - make 5 ch

R2 - starting from the 2nd ch  
from hook, make 3 sc, in 4rd ch  
make 3 sc, turn about 180  
degrees. Now the bottom edge is  
on the top. Make 3 sc. There are  
10 stitches. Now, make around.

\*Check the diagram below.

R3 - sc around (10)

R4 - 1 inc, 4 sc, 1 inc, 4 sc. (12)

R5 - R7 - sc around (12)

R8 - 1 dec, 4 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc (10)

R9 - sc around (10)

FO and leave a long thread, you  
will use it to sew arms. Fill it  
with stuffing just a little bit, only  
the thicker part - to above the  
7th row. Leave the remaining,  
thin part empty.

How to start  
Arms and Legs:

start slst ch sc

## Legs

Make 2. Creamy.

R1 - R9 - the same like Arms

R10 - R12 - sc around (10)

Finish like Arms.

# Nose

1. Cut about 1 m. black thread and thread the needle with it. At the end of the thread few knots all in one place, just until you get something like a small ball/pellet shape.
2. The next step is to warp a thread around it few times and then insert few times through the ball with your thread and needle.
3. Repeat until you are satisfied (4.) with the ball size and shape.
5. Again, leave a long thread.



# Horns

Brown. Make 2.

Part 1.

R1 - 4sc in magic ring  
or make 2 ch and make 4sc in 2nd  
ch form the hook (4)

R2 - R3 - sc around (4)

R4 - FLO: 1dec, 2sc, (3)

R5 - 1inc, 2sc, (4)

R6 - R10 - sc around (4)

Part 2. Make 2.

R1 - 4sc in magic ring  
or make 2 ch and make 4sc in 2nd  
ch form the hook (4)

R2 - R3 - sc around (4)

Sew both parts. Check the picture.

# Tail

Creamy.

R1 - 4sc in magic ring  
or make 2 ch and make 4sc in  
2nd ch form the hook (4)

R2 - inc around

R3 - 1sc, 3x inc, 1sc, 3x inc (14)

R4 - R5 - sc around

R6 - 1 dec, 4sc, 1 dec, 6sc (12)

R7 - 1 dec, 4sc, 1dec, 4sc (10)

R8 - R9 - sc around (10)



# Muzzle

White.

R1 - 7ch

R2 - 1sc in 2nd ch from the hook,  
1sc, 3 x inc, 2sc (10)



# Ears

Creamy. Make 2.

R1 - 8ch

R2 - 1slst in 2nd ch from the hook,  
1sc, 1hdc, dc inc, 1hdc, 2sc,

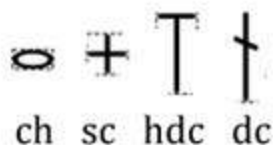
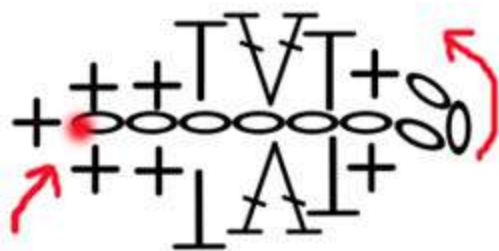
R3 - turn about 90 degrees,  
make 1sc,

R4 - turn about 90 degrees,  
now the bottom edge is on the top

2sc, 1hdc, dc inc, 1hdc, 1sc, 1slst

Check the diagram below.

How to make ears?



# Finishing

Use long ends to sew parts together. Sew eyes and nose to upper part of the body. Sew arms on both sides of the body just around the height of the nose. Sew ears and horns on top of the body. Turn the deer upside down. Now look at it and imagine there's a diameter between arms, just in the middle of circle. Sew legs a little bit diagonally. Sew a tail to the back and you're done! Weave in ends.
