Fox - Woollky - The Forrest Troop

Woollky - Wool balls - brought to life by a forest witch to guard her hut. Night watch and air patrol of the forest. Foxy, is a good friend. Sometimes he likes to listen to good music.

Abbreviations:

R - round
ch - chain
sl st - slip stitch
sc - single crochet
inc - increase / make two sc form one loop
dec - decrease / invisible decrease or two
sc together
fo - fasten off

Mark first stitch of each round.

You will need:

- orange, black and white yarn
- hook 3,5 mm or 4 mm
- polyester fiberfill
- yarn needle

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Body

Orange.

R1 - 6 sc in magic ring or make 2 ch and make 6 sc in 2nd ch from the hook (6)

R2 - inc around (12)

R3 - *1 sc, 1 inc* around (18)

R4 - *2 sc, 1 inc* around (24)

R5 - *3 sc, 1 inc* around (30)

R6 - *4 sc, 1 inc* around (36)

R7 - *5 sc, 1 inc* around (42)

R8 - R12 - sc around (42)

White.

R13-R20 - sc around (42)

R21 - *5 sc, 1 dec* around (36)

R22 - sc around (36)

R23 - *4 sc, 1 dec* around (30)

R24 - *3 sc, 1 dec* around (24)

Start stuffing.

R26 - *2 sc, 1 dec* around (18)

R27 - *1 sc, 1 dec* around (12)

R28 - 4 x dec

FO and sew.

Arms

White. Make 2.

R1 - make 5 ch

R2 - starting from the 2nd ch from hook, make 3 sc, in 4rd ch make 3 sc, turn about 180 degrees. Now the bottom edge is on the top. Make 3 sc. There are 10 stitches. Now, make around.
*Check the diagram below.

R3 - sc around (10)

R4 - 1 inc, 4 S.C., 1inc, 4 sc. (12)

Orange.

R5 - R7 - sc around (12)

R8 - 1 dec, 4 S.C., 1 dec, 4 sc (10)

R9 - sc around (10)

FO and leave a long thread, you will use it to sew arms. Fill it with stuffing just a little bit, only the thicker part - to above the 7th row. Leave the remaining, thin part empty.

How to start
Arms and Legs:



• • 0 +
start slst ch sc

Legs

Make 2.

R1 - R9 - the same like Arms

R10 - R12 - sc around (10)

Finish like Arms.

Nose

1. Cut about 1 m. black thread and thread the needle with it. At the end of the thread few knots all in one place, just until you get something like a small ball/pellet shape.
2. The next step is to warp a thread around it few times and then insert few times through the ball with your thread and needle.
3. Repeat until you are satisfied (4.) with the ball size and shape.
5. Again, leave a long thread.



Ears

Orange. Make 2.

R1 - 7 ch, 6 sc, turn (7)

R2 - 1 ch, 6 sc, turn (7)

R3 - 1 ch, 1 dec, 2 sc, 1 dec, turn (5)

R4 - 1 ch, 4 sc, turn (5)

R5 - 1 ch, 2 dec, turn (3)

R6 - 1 ch, 1 dec, turn (2)

Now, make around:

R1 - 1 sc in every loop, it will be 17 sc

R2 - sc around (17)

To the end make 1 sl st. FO and leave long tail.

Muzzle

Attache yarn to above the 8th row of body (the last orange round), make:

R1 - 7 sc turn

R2 - 1 ch, 1 dec, 3 sc, 1 dec, turn (5)

R3 - 1 ch, 1 dec, 1 sc, 1 dec, turn (3)

R4 - 1 ch, 1 dec, 1 sc, turn (2)

R5 - 1 ch, 1 dec

FO and sew the tringle to the body.

Tail

White.

R1 - 6 sc in magic ring
or make 2 ch and make 6 sc in 2nd ch form the hook (6)

R2 - inc around

R3 - 1sc, 3x inc, 1sc, 3x inc (14)

R4 - R5 - sc around

R6 - 1 dec, 4sc, 1 dec, 6sc (12)

R7 - sc around (12)

Orange.

R8 - sc around (12)

R9 - 1 dec, 4sc, 1 dec, 4sc (10)

R10 - R11 - sc around (10)

R12 - 1 dec, 3sc, 1 dec, 3sc (8)

R13 - R18 - sc around (8)

FO and leave long tail.





Finishing

Use long ends to sew parts together. With the black and white yarn make eyes. Sew nose to the muzzle. Sew arms on both sides of the body. Sew ears on top of the body. Turn the fox upside down. Now look at it and imagine there's a diameter between arms, just in the middle of circle. Sew legs a little bit diagonally. Sew a tail to the back and you're done! Weave in ends.
