Mouse - Woollky - The Forrest Troop

Woollky - Wool balls - brought to life by a forest witch to guard her hut. The mouse in his free time likes to nibble the grass around the hut on the chicken foot.

Abbreviations:

R - round
ch - chain
sl st - slip stitch
sc - single crochet
inc - increase / make two sc form one loop
dec - decrease / invisible decrease or two
sc together
fo - fasten off

Mark first stitch of each round.

You will need:

- grey, black and white yarn
- hook 3,5 mm or 4 mm
- polyester fiberfill
- yarn needle

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Body

Grey.

R1 - 6 sc in magic ring
or make 2 ch and make 6 sc in
2nd ch form the hook (6)

R2 - inc around (12)

R3 - *1 sc, 1 inc* around (18)

R4 - *2 sc, 1 inc* around (24)

R5 - *3 sc, 1 inc* around (30)

R6 - *4 sc, 1 inc* around (36)

R7 - *5 sc, 1 inc* around (42)

R8 - R20 - sc around (42)

R21 - *5 sc, 1 dec* around (36)

R22 - sc around (36)

R23 - *4 sc, 1 dec* around (30)

R24 - *3 sc, 1 dec* around (24)

Start stuffing

R26 - *2 sc, 1 dec* around (18)

R27 - *1 sc, 1 dec* around (12)

R28 - 6 x dec (6)

FO and sew.

Arms

Make 2. Grey.

R1 - make 5 ch

R2 - starting from the 2nd ch
from hook, make 3 sc, in 4rd ch
make 3 sc, turn about 180
degrees. Now the bottom edge is
on the top. Make 3 sc. There are
10 stitches. Now, make around.

*Check the diagram below.

R3 - sc around (10)

R4 - 1 inc, 4 sc, 1 inc, 4 sc. (12)

R5 - R7 - sc around (12)

R8 - 1 dec, 4 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc (10)

R9 - sc around (10)

FO and leave a long thread, you
will use it to sew arms. Fill it
with stuffing just a little bit, only
the thicker part - to above
the 7th row. Leave the remaining,
thin part empty. Sewing in 2
places with black thread make
something like fingers alike.

How to start
Arms and Legs:



• • 0 +
start slst ch sc

Legs

Make 2. Grey.

R1 - R9 - the same like Arms

R10 - R12 - sc around (10)

Finish like Arms.

Nose

1. Cut about 1 m. black thread and thread the needle with it. At the end of the thread few knots all in one place, just until you get something like a small ball/pellet shape.
2. The next step is to warp a thread around it few times and then insert few times through the ball with your thread and needle.
3. Repeat until you are satisfied (4.) with the ball size and shape.
5. Again, leave a long thread.



Ears

Make 2. Grey.

R1 - 6 sc in magic ring

or make 2 ch and make 6 sc in
2nd ch form the hook (6)

R2 - inc around (12)

R3 - *1 sc,1 inc* around (18)

R4 - *2 sc,1 inc* around (24)

FO and leave long tail.

Eyes

Make 2. White.

R1 - 6 sc in magic ring

or make 2 ch and make 6 sc in
2nd ch form the hook (6)

R2 - inc around (12)

FO and leave long tail. With balck
yarn sew the pupils.

Tail

Grey.

R1 - 50 ch

R2 - sc in every chain (50)

FO and leave long tail.

Finishing

Use long ends to sew parts
together. Sew eyes and nose to
upper part of the body. Sew arms
on both sides of the body just
around the heught of the nose.
Sew ears on top of the body. Turn
the mouse upside down. Now
lokk at it and imagine there's a
diameter between arms, just in
the middle of circle. Sew legs a
little bit diagonally. Sew a tail
to the back and you're done! Weave
in ends.
