

# crochet pattern by babayaga



## Raccoon - Woollky - Forrest Troop

Woollky, wool balls - brought to life by a forest witch to guard her hut. In moments free from patrol, he finds and brings interesting objects to the hut.

### Abbreviations:

R - round  
ch - chain  
sl st - slip stitch  
sc - single crochet  
inc - increase / make two sc form one loop  
dec - decrease / invisible decrease or two  
sc together  
fo - fasten of

**Mark first stitch of each round.**

### You will need:

- grey, black and white yarn
- hook 3,5 mm or 4 mm
- polyester fiberfill
- yarn needle

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# Body

Grey.

R1 - 6 sc in magic ring  
or make 2 ch and make 6 sc in 2nd  
ch form the hook (6)

R2 - inc around (12)

R3 - \*1 sc, 1 inc\* around (18)

R4 - \*2 sc, 1 inc\* around (24)

R5 - \*3 sc, 1 inc\* around (30)

R6 - \*4 sc, 1 inc\* around (36)

White.

R7 - \*5 sc, 1 inc\* around (42)

Black.

R8 - R11 - sc around (42)

White.

R12 - sc around (42)

Grey.

R13 - R20 - sc around (42)

R21 - \*5 sc, 1 dec\* around (36)

R22 - sc around (36)

R23 - \*4 sc, 1 dec\* around (30)

R24 - \*3 sc, 1 dec\* around (24)

Start stuffing.

R25 - \*2 sc, 1 dec\* around (18)

R26 - \*1 sc, 1 dec\* around (12)

R27 - 6 x dec (6)

FO and sew.

# Arms

Black. Make 2.

R1 - make 5 ch

R2 - starting from the 2nd ch  
from hook, make 3 sc, in 4rd ch  
make 3 sc, turn about 180  
degrees. Now the bottom edge is  
on the top. Make 3 sc. There are  
10 stitches. Now, make around.  
\*Check the diagram below.

Grey.

R3 - sc around (10)

R4 - 1 inc, 4 sc, 1 inc, 4 sc. (12)

R5 - R7 - sc around (12)

R8 - 1 dec, 4 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc (10)

R9 - sc around (10)

FO and leave a long thread, you  
will use it to sew arms. Fill it  
with stuffing just a little bit, only  
the thicker part - to above the  
7th row. Leave the remaining,  
thin part empty.

How to start  
Arms and Legs:

start   slst   ch   sc

# Legs

Make 2.

R1 - R9 - the same like Arms

R10 - R12 - sc around (10)

Finish like Arms.

# Nose

1. Cut about 1 m. black thread and thread the needle with it. At the end of the thread few knots all in one place, just until you get something like a small ball/pellet shape.
2. The next step is to warp a thread around it few times and then insert few times through the ball with your thread and needle.
3. Repeat until you are satisfied (4.) with the ball size and shape.
5. Again, leave a long thread.



## Ears

Grey. Make 2.

R1 - 6ch, turn (6)

R2 - 1sc in 2nd ch from the hook, 4sc, turn (5)

R3 - 1ch, 5sc, turn (5)

R4 - 1ch, 5sc, turn (5)

R5 - 1ch, 1dec, 1sc, 1dec, turn (4)

R6 - 1ch, 1dec, 1sc turn (2)

Now, make around:

R1 - 1 sc in every loop, it will be 16-18 sc

R2 - sc around (16-18)

To the end make 1 sl st. FO and leave long tail.

Part 2 of the ears. Black. Make 2.

R1 - 5ch, turn

R2 - 1sc in 2nd ch from the hook, 3sc, turn (4)

R3 - 1ch, 4sc, turn (4)

R4 - 1ch, 2 dec

FO and leave a long thread.

## Muzzle

White.

Start like arms or legs. End after finishing round 2. Leave a long thread. Using a long thread tie around 2-3 times through the middle of an oval so it creates 2 cheeks. Tighten hard and sew 2 times.

## Tail

Black.

R1 - 6 sc in magic ring  
or make 2 ch and make 6 sc in 2nd ch from the hook (6)

R2 - inc around

R3 - 1sc, 3x inc, 1sc, 3x inc (14)

Grey.

R4 - R5 - S.C. around

R6 - 1 dec, 4sc, 1 dec, 6sc (12)

Black.

R7 - R8 - sc around (12)

R9 - 1 dec, 4sc, 1 dec, 4sc (10)

Grey.

R10 - R11 - sc around (10)

R12 - 1 dec, 3sc, 1 dec, 3sc (8)

Black.

R13 - R15 - sc around (8)

Grey.

R16 - R18 - sc around (8)

FO and leave long tail.





Notice! Finally I did different eyes than on this picture.

## Finishing

Use long ends to sew parts together. Between rows 8 and 12 sew the eyes with black and grey yarn. Sew nose at the top between cheeks.. Sew muzzle between the eyes. Sew arms on both sides of the body. On the bottom edge, in the middle of the ears sew black elements. Sew ears on top of the body. Turn the racoon upside down. Now look at it and imagine there's a diameter between arms, just in the middle of circle. Sew legs a little bit diagonally. Sew a tail to the back and you're done! Weave in ends.
